

## **Special Education**

Special education services, accommodations and modifications will be provided, as appropriate, for students per their IEP.

### **If school were to close, how would my child receive their special education services?**

All students eligible for special education services have the option to come to the building to receive their special education services, receive their special education services remotely or a combination of both.

### **When will my child's services be provided?**

All services will be provided during the regular school day. A student's specific schedule will be developed by and communicated through the special education teacher and/or specialist assigned to deliver the specific service.

### **What if my child is in a district special education classroom where the curriculum is based on alternative learning standards (MAP-A) and/or significantly modified to meet his/her educational needs?**

Online Learning is available to address IEP goals and support student needs. There will be assigned daily online times the special education teacher will meet with students to work on skills specific to the student's IEP goals. These times will be pre-arranged with the family and could be individual or in a small group setting. All special education and related services will be provided **during the typical school day**.

### **Could my child still have access to the general education classroom?**

Yes, students will have access to the general education classroom.

### **Will my child receive the same amount of services during a school closure?**

While these decisions are made by the IEP team, the amount and frequency of specific services may need revision to provide Free and Appropriate Public Education (FAPE) in an online learning environment.
